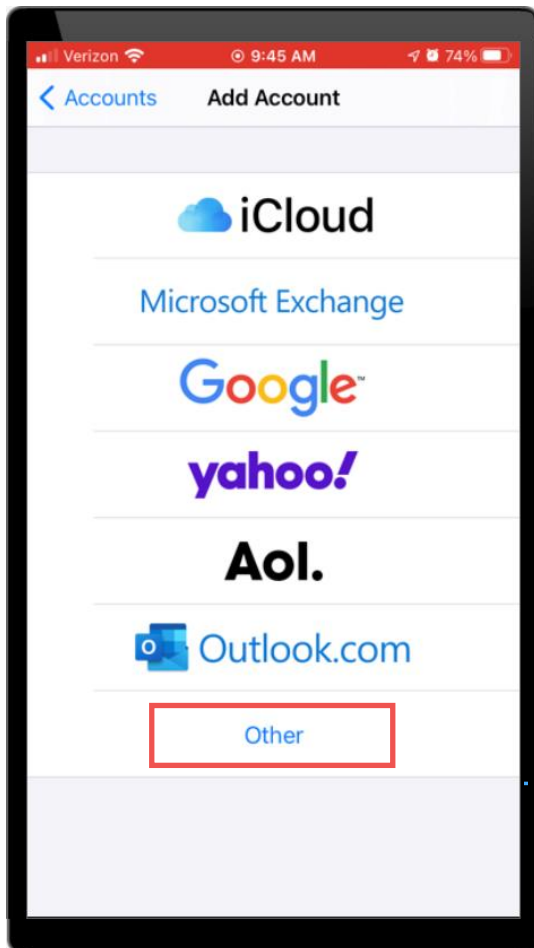


## Nefcom Email Settings for iPhone & iOS Devices

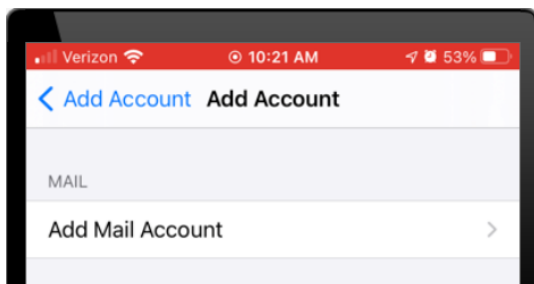
This guide was created using iOS version 14.6

From the Home Screen of your iPhone, you will tap on **Settings > Mail > Accounts > Add Account**

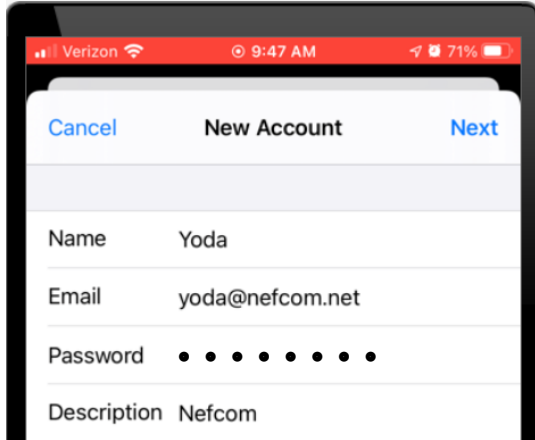
Select **Other**



Tap **Add Mail Account**



Enter your **Name**, **Email**, and **Password**. **Description** can be anything you would like. Then tap **Next**.

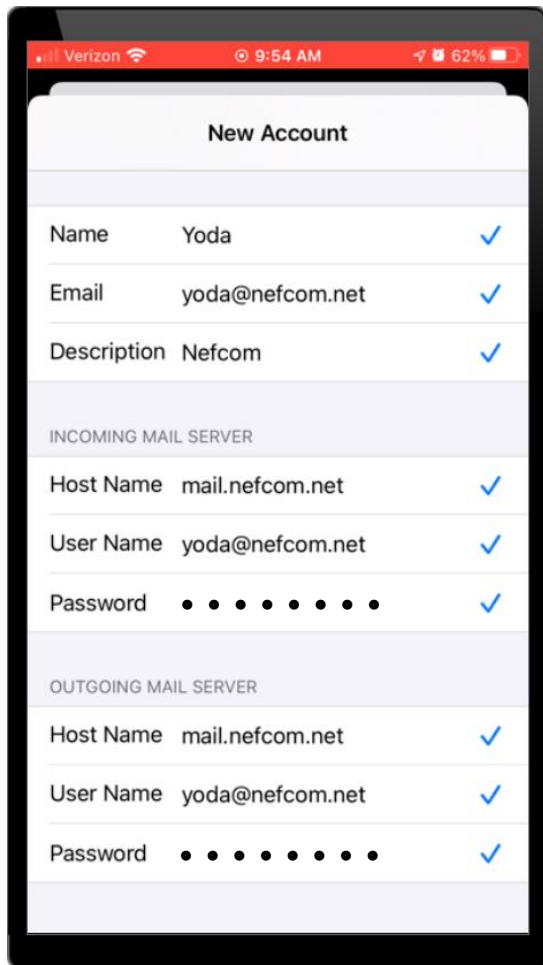
Choose **IMAP** and enter the following server information.

Make sure that you provide User Name and Password under both Incoming and Outgoing Mail Server. The User Name will be your email account. Tap **Next**.

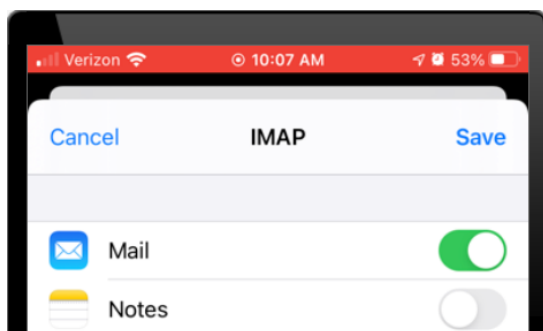
